What CWC Did

An Options Diagnostic was undertaken by carrying out a desktop study to shortlist the Client's aims and objectives regarding their procurement. We facilitated a workshop on the principles of collaborative best practice and the procurement models commonly in use within the industry, the outcome of which was to shortlist three preferred procurement options. We undertook in-depth investigations into the three shortlisted options, from the qualitative and quantitative viewpoints, then ran a concluding workshop to review the final findings regarding the three preferred models; the stakeholders then chose one.
